Objectives: This introductory course covers the key elements and methods of HTA and combines lectures, discussions, case study group work, and hands-on computer lab session.

Description: By the end of the course, participants will be familiar with:

- Systematic reviews and Economic Evidence
- Critical study appraisal
- Costing/Cost of Illness Methods
- Decision-analytic modeling (+ computer tutorial)
- HTA examples from around the world

The workshop will consist of presentations, demonstrations, group work and discussion. Group work will include hands-on exercise on search strategies, critical appraisal, and modeling using MS-Excel, and TreeAge. Participants should bring their own laptops for exercises during the workshop.
